THOUGHT QUESTION: How was Noah saved?

5. Genesis 6:14

Yes – No Would Noah have obeyed God if he used any other type of wood?

THOUGHT QUESTION: Does God have to tell us everything not to do, or just what to do?

6. Leviticus 10:1-2

Yes – No Was the fire that Nadab and Abihu used authorized by God?

THOUGHT QUESTION: Who authorized this fire that Nadab and Abihu used?

7. Matthew 15:9

THOUGHT QUESTION: How were these people worshiping God in vain?

8. II John 9-11; Colossians 3:17

Yes – No Must our worship be by Jesus' authority?

2. Acts 2:42

3. Matthew 28:20 (Fill in the blank at the bottom)

- Yes – No Did Jesus command the apostles to teach those who were disciples?

4. Acts 2:42

- Yes – No Did the early Christians “*continue steadfastly in the apostles doctrine?*”

5 Acts 20:7

- Yes – No When the disciples came together to break bread, did Paul preach to them?

6. Ephesians 6:18; I Thessalonians 5:17 (Fill in the blank at the bottom)

- Yes – No Are we commanded to pray?

7. Acts 12:5

- Yes – No Did the church offer prayer for Peter?

8. Acts 2:42

- Yes – No Was prayer included in their worship?

9. Matthew 26:26-29 (Fill in the blank at the bottom)

Yes – No Do these passages mention a mechanical instrument of music?
